

IMPORTING CITATIONS FROM PUBMED INTO REFWORKS

IN PUBMED:

1. Mark the citations you wish to import by checking the box next to the citation
2. Scroll to the top of the citation display
3. Use the drop-down menu to change the **Display** to **MEDLINE**
4. Use the drop-down menu to change the **Send To** option to **TEXT**. Click on the **Send To** button
5. Save your file as a **text file (with a .txt extension)** to the location of your choice (e.g. desktop)

IN REFWORKS:

1. Login to your RefWorks account
2. Click on the **Import** button
3. Under the **Import Filter/Data Source** drop-down menu select **the University of Minnesota Libraries, Twin Cities**
4. Under the **Database** drop-down menu select **PubMed [NLM PUBMED]**
5. Keep the radio button selected under **Import data from the following Text File**, select **Browse** to locate the file you saved from your search, then choose **Open**
6. Click the **Import** button

Your citation(s) will be imported into the **Last Imported Folder**. You may now move them into the folder of your choice.
