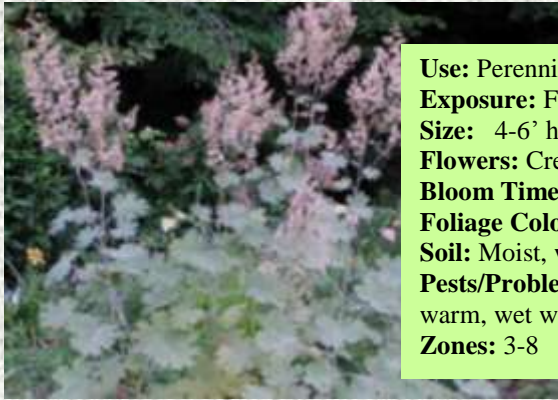


Plume Poppy
Macleaya cordata



Use: Perennial, specimen plant.
Exposure: Full sun
Size: 4-6' high x 4' wide
Flowers: Cream colored
Bloom Time: Mid to late summer
Foliage Color: Light green
Soil: Moist, well drained
Pests/Problems: Anthracnose during warm, wet weather.
Zones: 3-8

Specimen plant, good for cutting or drying. Tends to be invasive. Division should be done every 3-4 years to reduce size of each clump. Also self sows.
